We were able to worship at both church plants, New Life Baptist Church and Good News Baptist Church, and both churches are still growing under their national pastors, Pastor Chavannes and Pastor Ronald. Pastor Ronald's church held their annual end of the year Thanksgiving Service to celebrate all of the good things that the Lord has blessed them with over the year. The most blessed part of the service was seeing Pastor Ronald's mother, the wife of a witch doctor who was saved just after Pastor Ronald was ordained, singing in the church choir. **To God be the Glory for His Maintaining Power!!!**

Secondly, we were blessed to see how the Lord has **Sustained our Schools and Students!** The schools also continue to grow and educate over 600 children each day. Just think, five years ago, none of these students were even able to communicate at all! **To God be the Glory for His Sustaining Power!!!**

Thirdly, we were a little saddened and discouraged as we went through and cleaned out our house. It made us a little dismayed as we thought about returning to the field without our three oldest children. However, we spent much time reflecting on the ways that the Lord has **Provided for the Pearts**. Our house was full of items that many of you have sent in for our family and for our ministry. It was a blessing to be able to remember many of you, your generosity, and your faithful support of our family and ministry over the years. **To God be the Glory for His Providing Power!!!**

As we came home from our trip, the Lord has **Re-burdened our Hearts** for the people and ministry in Haiti. Our minds are overflowing with ideas and ways that we can grow and enhance the ministry. The Lord has already provided some substantial financial gifts to buy supplies and make repairs, and Sewing4Souls in Beaver, WV has provided dresses and outfits for the children in two of our schools. We are ready and eager to get back to reaching Haitians with the Gospel in as many ways possible. **To God be the Glory for His Saving Power!!!**
